Friendly Reminders...

Road Right-of-way

As we approach winter, please do not leave parked cars, parked trailers, or even large rocks in the road right-of-way. Things in the right-of-way makes snow plowing difficult and presents liability issues for you. The road right-of-way is approximately 15 feet either side of the roads.

Weeds and Lawn Care

Septic Tank Pumping

Homeowners are reminded to make sure they pump their septic tanks. Our covenants state that septic tanks need to be pumped at least every 4 years. If you can't remember when it was last pumped get a pumping scheduled.
